

<u>General info:</u>

Recommended Calibers and Ammunition:

- For Buffalo, Rhino, and Elephant, a minimum caliber of .375 is required.
- For Lions, Leopards, Antelopes, and other medium game, calibers such as 7mm, .300, or .30-06 are ideal.
- For big game, you should bring at least 40 full metal jacket cartridges and 40 soft point cartridges.
- For medium game, a minimum of 80 soft point cartridges is recommended.

Permits:

When making your booking, you must specify the animals you wish to hunt.

Hunters from CITES Convention member countries must provide a photocopy of the original CITES permit for Leopard, Elephant, Crocodile, Lion, Hippo, and all cats and primates.

Terms and Conditions:

- Animals wounded and lost will be paid in full plus 15% VAT
- Conservation funds \$10 per trophy taken and exported
- Cites license fees where applicable
- Permit fees where applicable
- Rifles rental at \$50 per client per day excluding the cost of ammo
- There is no VAT charged on the trophy fee if the trophies are to be exported under specific regulations set out by the Receiver of Revenue
- Animals in package that are not hunted or animals that are wounded and lost are subject to VAT

- Balance of daily fees or chosen package payable on or before arrival
- Please note: no VAT is levied on dipping, packing, and shipping services and/or for the tanning of skins, if tanned in South Africa
- Should the trophies be processed in South Africa VAT is levied between the taxidermy industry and the Receiver of Revenue
- A 20% deposit on the total daily rates or chosen package will confirm your booking
- The deposit is non-refundable, however, you can reschedule within two years
- All payments are check, ACH, wire, cash, or VISA/Mastercard
